There is light at the end of the tunnel, the timetable has been changed and a lot of the teething problems we have had has been rectified. A maths teacher has now been appointed. The HSIE teacher has been appointed. The timetable is now a ministerial and means Daryl cannot discuss the matter further until the minister has investigated this issue. 6. Reports <p>a) Principal's report – We just received all the HSC results for 2015. We have found that some subjects scale down the students results, for example Senior Science. This subject in some students has found they have been scaled down from a band 6 to a band 4.</p>		

<p>Overall our average band was band 5 with 44 students. We had 34 students receive a band 6. When broken down to the individual subjects, HSIE received an average 4.91 band, Science received a 5.20 band, Tas 4.9 Band, English 5.03 Band, Maths 5.36 band and Capa 5.7 Band We had 15 all-rounders. We are pleased that 5 students were offered to study biomed at UNSW, 8 students in Actuarial studies, one of our indigenous student received a scholarship to study a law degree at UNSW.
