One student's story has lived on at Hurlstone Agricultural High School a year after his graduation.

Lachlan Delves, who last year finished year 12 at the Glenfield school, survived cancer, and every year Hurlstone holds their own National Bandanna Day celebration to support Mr Delves' journey and the CanTeen charity.

Bandanna Day was held on Friday, October 31, coinciding with Halloween, and the school's social justice group, Hurlstone Interact, sold more than 130 bandannas and \$700 of CanTeen merchandise.

The Halloween-themed goal of the day, which was sponsored by Ingleburn Rotary Club, was to 'Make Cancer less of a Nightmare for Teenagers'.
