



# Naming of academically selective high school at Glenfield

## Background information

Sydney's south west is experiencing unprecedented growth in homes and jobs. In response to this growth, the NSW Department of Education is investing more than \$130 million in public education infrastructure in South Western Sydney. \$30 million of this investment will be directed to the Glenfield educational precinct.

The Glenfield educational precinct will include:

- A renewed academically selective high school on the site of the Hurlstone Agricultural High School at Glenfield, which will have capacity for more than 1,000 academically gifted and talented students and be operating with its new identity, including a new name, by 2023
- The upgrade of three special educational schools to increase the number of classes and improve facilities. These schools are Ajuga School, Campbell House School and Glenfield Park School
- Land set aside for a new primary school in the precinct to cater for up to 1,000 students. The location, educational offerings and name of the school are yet to be determined.

In 2020 Hurlstone Agricultural High School will move to Western Sydney University's Hawkesbury Campus at Richmond. Hurlstone Agricultural High School will be an academically selective agriculture and STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) school for 1,500 students across NSW, with state of the art boarding facilities.

A renewed academically selective high school on the site of the current Hurlstone Agricultural School at Glenfield will serve the broader community by 2023.

## Consultation overview

Planning for the renewed academically selective high school at Glenfield is still in the early stages. The Department understands the importance of involving stakeholders and the community in the planning of the renewed school.

One of the first opportunities for consultation is on what the renewed school should be named.

The Department of Education is seeking community feedback to guide its decision on the selection of a name for the renewed high school at Glenfield. The Department wants to gather community thoughts and ideas on what needs to be reflected in the name.
