The selection panel will gain an insight into prospective students' achievements, attitude, commitment and willingness to engage in school and community activities through reviewing documentation and entrance results.

The selection process will include:

1. An entrance examination.

2. Review of documentation. Please attach the following documentation with your application. **DO NOT** include originals.

- Recent school reports
- NAPLAN reports (Please provide last available Naplan results)
- Certificates of attainment (academic, sporting, etc.)
- Photograph Identification Form (enclosed)

To assist families in deciding whether an application is in their child's best interest the following information regarding vacancies is supplied:

Year 8 – 0

Year 9 – 0

Year 10 – 0

Year 11 – 0

While at present there are no vacancies in Years 8 – 11, students sometimes leave the school due to family situations or as they have received an offer of placement at another institution.

Each application will be assessed on its own merits and will take into account the exam, the personal data supplied and the family's situation including proximity to educational services.

Applicants will be placed in a priority order. Vacancies will be filled in this order and a reserve list created for all years. In the event that a vacancy becomes available the next student on the reserve list will be offered the position.

Applications close on **28 July 2017**. **An administration fee of \$55 inclusive of GST is required upon applications.** Cheques should be made payable to "Hurlstone Agricultural High School". This administration fee helps to cover the costs of administration, examination supervisors and the marking of the papers.

In line with the Minister of Education's announcement made in 2015 regarding the current Hurlstone site, student's residing in the metropolitan areas will not be considered for boarding school placements.

Methods of payment are:

A cheque by mail when returning application and identification form or EFTPOS, Cash or Cheque payments can be made at the school's Accounts Office – between 8.30am and 2:45pm.
